1. LEGAL STATUS

14. FORCE MAJEURE: OTHER CHANGES IN CONDITIONS

In the event of as soon as possible after the occurrence of any cause constituting force majeure, the Supplier shall give notice and full particulars in writing to Muslim Aid (MAP) of such occurrence or change if the Supplier / Contractor is hereby rendered unable.

Wholly or in part, to perform its obligations and meet its responsibilities under this Order. The Supplier / Contractor shall also notify Muslim Aid (MAP) of any other changes in conditions or the occurrence of any even which interferes or threatens to interfere with its performance of this purchase Order.
